Amendment Summary

Charter Amendment – Baltimore Regional Transportation Authority Mandate Fund

- This amendment to the Baltimore City Charter will establish the Baltimore Regional Transportation Authority Mandate Fund (TAMF);
- The TAMF shall be used to promote, negotiate, conclude, and maintain a Compact in which the City of Baltimore and other jurisdictions in the Baltimore region agree to seek enabling legislation for a Baltimore Regional Transportation Authority (BRTA);
- Upon securing enabling legislation, the BRTA will be empowered to plan, design, build, operate, maintain, and finance a regional transportation system.
- Revenue sources for the TAMF established by this Section may include:
 - (1) An annual mandatory appropriation to the TAMF in the Ordinance of Estimates in an amount not less than \$1,000,000;
 - (2) Grants and donations;
 - (3) Mandatory and voluntary payments made pursuant to ordinances;
 - (4) Tax increment financing revenue and any other source established by ordinance;
- The TAMF shall be overseen, governed, and administered by an eleven-member TAMF Commission with diversity in its membership and appointed by the Mayor and Baltimore City Council;
